


SET OUT


- 1. Measure and mark out the space for your sign to be installed.
- 2. Clean the surface if required.

CUT THROUGH OR ENGRAVED SIGN - ON STANDOFFS


1. Put the sign on the wall, ensure it is level, and use the predrilled holes to mark out with pen.




2. Unscrew the face off of each standoff mounting spacer and mount the standoffs into the wall on the predrilled hole markings (using your own fixing method appropriate to the substrate you are attaching to).



3. Place backing (if using) and sign over standoff mounting spacers.



4. Screw the face pieces of the standoff mounting spacers back into place.




- 1. Measure and mark out the space for your sign to be installed.

CUT THROUGH BOX SIGN


1. On the mounting surface measure and mark two vertical lines for the mounting angles - using the distance below that matches your house sign size. Then mark a level horizontal line for the top of the mounting angles.




3. Slide backing and sign over mounting angles.



2. Fix supplied mounting angles to the mounting surface (using your own fixing method appropriate to the substrate you are attaching to), with outside edge on the lines previously marked, ensuring they are level.



4. Line up predrilled holes in angles with holes in sign and then tech screw in (with impact driver using phillips bit) from side using supplied screws.
